

Driver Education Registration

Centennial School District

The Centennial School District's Drivers Education Program is designed to meet the State of Oregon, Department of Transportation requirements. To meet these requirements and qualify for State Certification students must successfully complete 30 or more hours of classroom instruction and 12 or more hours of in-car instruction. Both the classroom instruction and in-car instruction will be taught during the same period of time. Students must have their learners permit before they can sign up for the class. This course is graded on a pass/fail basis with 80% required to pass the program.

All students must make a time commitment to both the classroom and driving instruction schedule. Attendance for specified hours is mandatory. Students failing to attend scheduled classroom and driving appointments will be dropped from the program with no refunds. Students who miss behind the wheel classes, that can be re-scheduled, will be charged an additional \$43.00 per-hour for make-up time.

Each classroom-driving session lasts approximately six (6) weeks. Enrollment is limited to 24 students per class. The first 24 students who meet the registration requirements for each class session will be assigned a time slot. A minimum of fifteen (15) students is required for the class to be held. Students with their parent/guardian will need to schedule a driving time at the parent night meeting. Students who do not show up with a parent/guardian at parent night will not be allowed to participate in the classes.

To enroll in a session students must bring the completed registration form, their permit/license and the participation fee to the Athletic Office during the designated "enrollment period" (see attached Driver's Education Registration Form for applicable dates). The cost of the program is \$295.00 for permitted drivers and \$590.00 for licensed drivers and students who are age 18 prior to the end of the class. (The State will not give reimbursement to the school district for those students who have a license or have turned 18 prior to the end of the program.)

I wish to make an application to participate in the Centennial School District Driver Education Program. I have received my Oregon Learner's Permit and will carry it with me to all driving sessions. I am willing to give the time and effort necessary to fulfill the requirements of this program as outlined in the information sheet and as set forth by the Oregon Department of Transportation. I understand that to complete the course a student must complete 30 hours of classroom instruction and a minimum of twelve hours of in-car instruction. As such, I understand that failure to complete the course within the allotted time will result in termination from the program (with no refund). Students who miss their scheduled classroom/driving time will be assessed a \$43.00 per hour fee for make-up sessions.

I further understand that I am covered by school insurance only while driving in the School Driver Education vehicle and that I am required to drive a minimum of 8 additional hours with a parent, guardian or adult friend during the in-car instruction time in order to complete the program. ***A parent, guardian or adult friend must attend the parent orientation class with the student, as outlined in the information sheet*** to receive information on Oregon's graduated licensing law, the Centennial Driver Education program and the parent's involvement in the process to fulfill the requirements as set forth by the Oregon State Department of Transportation.

Bring this completed form, a check for \$295.00 for permit or \$590.00 for licensed drivers and drivers 18 years or older, made out to Centennial School District and your permit/license to the Athletic Office.
